GENENTECH'S NEW BIOLOGICS MANUFACTURING FACILITY

Genentech's Oceanside Campus

Genentech is investing \$450 million in advanced manufacturing capabilities at its Oceanside campus, with plans to add 150 local, full-time jobs. The new 80,000 sq. ft. biologic facility will be the first in the Roche global manufacturing network designed specifically for the fast and sustainable commercial production of biologics for smaller patient populations, including rare diseases and personalized medicines.

Genentech's Oceanside facility, which was established in 2005, currently has seven buildings on 60 acres at 1 Antibody Way in the Ocean Ranch Corporate Centre.
